



# LABA GRAVEL REGULATION 2025

## 1. MODALITY OF THE EVENT:

1.1 The LABA GRAVEL gravel event will have a maximum of 49 participants on each course and all persons registered for the LABA GRAVEL gravel event indicate that they are aware of this fact.

1.2. The event is a non-stop, non-competitive and self-sufficient format. Given the nature of the event, there will be no broom car or ambulance.

1.3. Everyone must pay the registration fee for the event. The registration fee includes Civil Liability.

All participants must wear the jersey provided by LABA GRAVEL.

## 2. ROUTES

2.1. There will be three routes and one of them must be chosen at the time of registration.

2.2. LABA 270: it will have a length of 270 kilometres and a difference in altitude of approximately 5500 metres. It will be compulsory to carry the geolocator provided by the organisation.

2.3. LABA 160: will have a length of 160 kilometres and a gradient of about 3000 metres. It will be compulsory to carry the geolocator provided by the organisation.

2.4. LABA 110: it will have a length of 110 kilometres and a gradient of about 1400 metres.

2.5. The registration fee for LABA 270 will be 70 €, LABA 160 will be 60 € and LABA 110 will be 50 €.

2.6. Participants will have to follow the route chosen at the time of registration by GPS. The routes will not be signposted.

2.7. Participants must choose one of the routes when registering. No changes will be accepted.

2.8. The organisers may make the necessary changes to LABA GRAVEL or cancel the race if weather conditions make it advisable or for reasons beyond their control.

2.9. If the participant abandons the course, it is obligatory to notify the organisers as soon as possible, by telephone or telegram.

2.10. Participants will have to follow the entire route provided by the organisation using GPS, as the route will not be signposted.

2.11. The track of the route will be delivered by e-mail one week before the start.

2.12. The routes pass through greenways, cycle paths and paths shared with pedestrians. The rules of these routes must be respected.

2.13. As this is neither a race nor a cycle ride, participants are subject to the highway code and the relevant authorities are free to intervene and act at their discretion. Therefore, no special priority is given to other road users on the route.

## 3. REGISTRATIONS AND LICENCES:

3.1. Participation in the LABA GRAVEL is open to all persons over 18 years of age.

3.2. The "Participant Declaration" must be SIGNED and signed, informing of the risks involved in participation and excluding the Organiser from any liability in the event of any incident or accident arising from participation in LABA GRAVEL.

3.3 With the registration fee will be given:

- The route in gpx format.
- Jersey, to be worn at the LABA GRAVEL event.
- Civil Liability Insurance.
- Supply
- Participant's bag
- Food and drink at the end.

3.4. No changes will be accepted after registration. If for any reason the participant is unable to participate in the LABA GRAVEL event, no refund will be made.

3.5. If the LABA GRAVEL event organisation suspends the event for any reason, no refund will be made.

#### **4. GEOLOCATOR:**

4.1. The organisation will provide a geolocator to each participant of LABA 270, LABA 160 and LABA 110.

4.2. The geolocator will inform the participants of the position of all participants at all times in order to improve their safety. It is mandatory to have it activated at all times.

4.3. The geolocator requires a deposit of 50 € to be paid at registration. The deposit will be returned a few days after the end of the event, after ensuring that the geolocator has been delivered in good condition.

4.4. In the event that the participant does not deliver the geolocator within 7 days after the end of the LABA GRAVEL event, he/she must prove the delivery of the tracker by registered mail, UPS, DHL or similar to the address to be communicated by the organisers of the LABA GRAVEL event. In case of loss or damage to the geolocator, the participant will be charged €150.

#### **5. REQUIREMENTS:**

5.1. Participants must carry their mobile phone charged and connected at all times in order to be reachable. It is advisable to carry an external battery or dynamo to guarantee the use of the mobile phone and GPS.

5.2. The use of helmets is compulsory for all participants.

5.3. Participants undertake to respect the rules of the road and private property through which they pass. On the routes there are

numerous fences, these must be left as they were before passing.

5.4. Participants also undertake not to litter and to respect the environment and cultural heritage wherever they go.

5.5. The LABA GRAVEL event is in a self-sufficient format, which means that participants are self-sufficient and must carry everything they need for the ride. They will be able to buy food and the necessary for the bike during the tour. They will only be able to receive external help in case of emergency.



5.6. On the LABA 270 course there will be a cut-off time at the refreshment post. The refreshment point will be located at kilometre point 176 of the route. Participants arriving after 18:00 on the day of the event will have to return to Andoain via the Plazaola greenway.

This cut-off time must be respected for the safety of the participants and to ensure that the logistics of the event are properly carried out.

5.7. Electric bikes are allowed, but the organisation must be informed. 5.8. No traction other than self-powered traction is allowed, except for electric bikes.

## **6. COMPULSORY MATERIAL:**

- It is compulsory to carry a rear and front light.
- Mobile phone, geolocator and GPS on throughout the event.
- Two cameras and a chain cutter.
- GPS with downloaded routes.
- Thermal blanket.
- Homologated helmet.
- Whistle.
- First aid kit (disinfectant, bandages and gauze).
- Up-to-date ID card or passport.

## **7. POSSIBLE MODIFICATIONS:**

7.1. The organisers may expel any person who impedes the course, breaches the rules or disobeys the instructions. 7.2. All participants undertake to read, accept and comply with the regulations.

7.3. The participant, by the mere fact of registering for the LABA GRAVEL event, accepts all the points of these regulations. Failure to comply with any of the rules may result in the withdrawal of the participant.

## **8. RIGHTS OF THE ORGANISER:**

8.1. In the event of an accident, the participant must notify the organisation as soon as possible. The organisation will not be responsible for any debts that the participant may incur during the event.

8.2. Neither the promoter of the event nor the organisers can be held responsible for traffic and individual accidents that may occur during the course of the event. In the brevet type events, the participant is considered to be undertaking a personal route. As it is neither a race nor a cycle ride and the participants are subject to the highway code, the competent authorities are free to intervene and act at their discretion.

Therefore, no special priority is given to other road users along the planned route.

8.3. The organisers reserve the right of admission to the event.

8.4. The organisation is committed to informing the authorities of those participants who do not respect the General Traffic Regulations in force. All those who do not respect the rules will be expelled from the event.

8.5. The rules may be modified at any point as required by the organiser. By registering you accept all points of these rules.

8.6. Each participant is responsible for his/her own safety and releases the organisation from any liability.



## **9. IN CASE OF NEED OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE:**

9.1. In case of an accident we recommend, whenever possible, to contact the organisation.

9.2. The participant, by the mere fact of participating, declines to take any legal action against the organiser or the promoter of the event. The event organisers cannot be held responsible for accidents that may occur during the event.

9.3. In case of abandonment due to mechanical breakdown or any other circumstance, the organisation shall be contacted at the telephone number to be communicated by the organisation at the technical meeting.

The organisation will be responsible for taking the participant to Andoain. To do so, they will have to approach a road in order to be transported.

## **10. IMAGE RIGHTS, LOPD and PRIVACY POLICY:**

10.1. Acceptance of these regulations obligatorily implies that the participant authorises the organisation of LABA GRAVEL to record all or part of his/her participation in the event and agrees that his/her image may be used for the promotion and dissemination of the image of LABA GRAVEL in all its forms (radio, TV, press, video, photo, DVD, Internet, posters, media, etc.). The participant grants all image rights relating to the commercial and advertising exploitation of his/her image that may be considered appropriate, without any right to any financial compensation.

10.2. The organisation guarantees full compliance with the regulations on Personal Data Protection and, therefore, in accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, the participant is informed and gives his/her consent to the incorporation of his/her data in the automatic files by the organiser and the processing of the same for use in relation to the execution of administrative and commercial procedures and other activities.

10.3. The participant accepts that his/her data may be transferred exclusively for activities necessary for the correct execution of the internal management and administration of the organiser. Likewise, the participant accepts that the organiser may send him/her information about news, procedures or services that affect the LABA GRAVEL. The participant's acceptance that his/her data may be processed or transferred in the manner described in this paragraph may be revoked, without retroactive effect, as stipulated in articles 6 and 11 of Organic Law 15/1999 of 13 December.
